# Temperature of Heat Lamps

***Is there a difference in temperature between red and clear or inside frosted heat lamps?***

**No.** The heat is determined by the wattage of the lamp. It has nothing to do with the color or finish of the glass.

Most people think things that are red are hot - like the expression "red hot." The red glass is used for the 250R40/10 lamp for those people that want the warning of the red glass. The color of the glass has nothing to do with the amount of heat generated by the lamp.

Think of the color lights you use on your Christmas tree. The red ones are not hotter than the yellow, blue or green ones.
